Three Unconscious Pathways to Representing the Analyst's Experience: Reverie, Countertransference Dreams and Joke Work

Dr. Lawrence Brown is a child and adult analyst at the Boston Psychoanalytic Institute (BPI). He is a Supervising Child Analyst and is the co-Chair of the BPI Child Analysis Programme. Dr. Brown is the Editor of the Psychoanalytic Quarterly and is the author of many scholarly articles. He has written several books titled "Intersubjective processes and the Unconscious: An Integration of Freudian, Kleinian and Bionian Perspectives" (2011) as well as the soon to be published book titled "Transformational Processes in Clinical Psychoanalysis: Dreaming, Emotions and the Present Moment".

This Symposium explores three pathways for representing the analyst's unconscious experience in the here-and -now of the clinical hour: reveries, countertransference dreams and joke work. These appear unbidden in the analyst's mind during the session and signal the analyst's unconscious work to give meaning to the emotions that arise within the context of the unconscious intersubjective field of the moment. Clinical material from the analysis of an adult man is presented to illustrate these pathways that unconsciously represent the emotions alive in the analytic encounter. Dr. Brown will do a Master Clinical Case Presentation on the same patient, interwoven with discussion by Dr. Charles Levin.
