He is the author of *Intersubjective Processes and the Unconscious: An Integration of Freudian, Kleinian and Bionian Perspectives (2011)*, and co-editor of *Growth & Turbulence in the Container/Contained: Bion's Continuing Legacy (L. Brown & H. Levine, 2013)* and *On Freud's 'Formulations on the Two Principles of Mental Functioning (L. Brown & G. Legorreta, 2016)*. His new book, *Transformational Processes in Clinical Psychoanalysis: Dreaming, Emotions and the Present Moment* was published in 2019 by IPA Publications and Routledge. He is the author of many scientific papers dealing with such topics as the Oedipus complex, trauma, countertransference dreams, the analytic setting, and aspects of Bion's work, in addition to autistic spectrum disorders in children and adolescents.
